Many ragpickers, man-hole cleaners, workers and many other types of people, who are now old and ill, are now living in such sad conditions. our organization help them.



2. WOMEN EMPOWERMENT ACTIVITIES

India is the fastest-growing economy in the world with almost half of the population as women. If the nation wants to get into the league of the developed nation then empowerment of women is need for the hour. Women's empowerment removes gender inequality and leads to a balanced economy. 3. FREE EDUCATION FOR POOR CHILDREN

4. EYE CHECKUP CAMP

Eye Checkup Camp Program Organized in "SALUKA SISHU SIKSHA NIKETAN" for poor patients suffering from cataracts. Patients are provided with consultation, surgery, accommodation, spectacles, medicine, transportation, and follow-up treatment. Cataracts are often related to the ageing process and found in older people, but they are also occasionally found in younger people. It is completely treatable but if left untreated, the person becomes totally blind. But due to poverty, many senior citizens live with blindness. A cataract is the clouding of the lens in the eye which leads to a decrease in vision. Symptoms may include faded colors, blurry or double vision, halos around light, trouble with bright lights, and trouble seeing at night. This may result in trouble driving, reading, or recognizing faces.



5. BLOOD DONATION CAMP

What better way to lend a helping hand to society than donate blood to those in ominous need of it. "SALUKA SISHU SIKSHA NIKETAN" Organization organizes blood donation camps time to tome, at different locations across west bengal. A recent event was held in connection with the 3rd anniversary celebrations of the World Blood Donors' day. Such campaigns have collected a total of 7000 units of blood in 40 camps over the past five years. "SALUKA SISHU SIKSHA NIKETAN" Organization arranges blood donation camp and collects blood for Thalassemia Patients every month, every month blood donors donate blood through A Giggles Welfare Organization to serve the humanity and to save the patients fighting with critical diseases like Thalassemia and other life threating disease. We are also spreading awareness on blood donation so more and more people come ahead to donate blood and serve the humanity.
